■ Net steps with how	<ul> <li>➤ We have a few exceptional behavior specialists</li> <li>➤ Put a formalized behavior plan in place. A written plan that is updated every 4-6 weeks.</li> <li>○ Moving away from The Incredible Years® and making a transition into The Pyramid Model.</li> <li>■ Behavior plans</li> <li>○ Is the parent involved in the behavior plan?</li> <li>➤ Yes, a committee is comprised of the parent, teacher, resource specialist etc.</li> <li>➤ If it's a child with an IEP, the behavior plan becomes part of the IEP.</li> <li>■ Pyramid Model – how much training is involved?</li> <li>○ Starts with foundational training and has 11 training modules.</li> <li>○ Train the trainers</li> <li>○ A leadership team to formalize the process</li> <li>➤ A representative from CCSA and DPfC to join the leadership team.</li> <li>○ <a href="http://modules.nceln.fpg.unc.edu/esd-self-paced-modules">http://modules.nceln.fpg.unc.edu/esd-self-paced-modules</a></li> <li>■ The Healthy Behavior Specialists and EChO uses this model</li> <li>■ Advocating to the County for a DPK Healthy Social Behavior Specialist.</li> </ul>
